We will continue online worship for the “Vulnerable” (those with heart conditions, respiratory issues, kidney disease or other chronic health concerns).

Recommended Guidelines for Worship Services

Doors open 15 minutes before service times. Please remain in your vehicle until the doors open. Remember: ***Minimize Risk, Maximize Safety!***

Masks: Masks are required. Feel free to bring your own. We have masks available if you need one.

Hand Sanitizers: There will be hand sanitizing stations placed throughout the building.

Doors Open: All exterior and interior doors will be propped open to minimize contact.

Strict Social Distancing: Seating will be clearly marked and staggered between pews and sections to preserve social distancing guidelines of a 6ft space between you and those around you, other than family. No handshakes and hugs.

Safe Exit Strategy: We have a guided exit strategy at the conclusion of the service.

Childcare: We regret that we cannot safely offer childcare at this time. We encourage you to have your family sit together in worship.

Limited Restroom Guidelines: We ask that you limit capacity to no more than 2 persons in a restroom at a time.

Giving: You will be able to give your tithes and offering through offering boxes placed around the sanctuary.

Cleaning: Our building is professionally cleaned each week and they diligently clean and disinfect surfaces and rooms each day. Between services, volunteers will clean and disinfect all surfaces: restrooms, pews, doors, handrails, etc. to maintain a safe environment.
